***Women on Italian Corporate Boards:
4 years after the introduction of the law***

The “*Women on Italian Corporate Boards*” event, organized by the Department of Economics and Management (University of Pisa) will take place in **Pisa**, from 10.00 on the **7th of April, 2017**.

The event will be developed with a number of thematic tables. The first round table will provide the understanding of quota law, listening to the prestigious board members’ point of view, both men and women. The second round table will focus on the involvement of Foundations and Associations in the gender debate in Italy. The third round table aims to make an international comparison among different countries. The last round table will be focus on the research agenda and future research interest about women on boards and top positions.

Among the main aims of “Women on Board in Italy” event there are the understating of:

- What are the main effects of the gender quota law implementation?
- How has been changed the dynamics of board with women representation?
- How can women use possibilities given by the gender quota law?
- How do men and women perceive the gender balanced board?
- How to avoid criticisms and problems that a strong regulation can imply?
- Making an international comparison among countries with different public policies about getting women on board (Norway, Spain and Slovenia).
