He is Full Professor of Behavioural Economics at Burgundy School of Business (France). After his PhD in Economics at European University Institute, Florence (Italy), he was professor in Spain at Universitat Jaume I and Universidad de Granada, and in UK at University of Reading. Since 2017 he is Director of the Laboratorio de Economia Experimental at Burgundy School of Business. His research interests are Behavioural economics—Decision; Economic analysis of law—Regulation; Experimental and Behavioural Economics--Economic Psychology; Experimental economics—Tourism; Industrial Organization--Wine Economic.

He has been teaching courses in Experimental economics; Industrial economics; Business applications; Game theory; Corporate social responsibility and Wine economics.

He has published in leading journals such as *Games and Economic Behavior*; *International Journal of Industrial Organization*; *Journal of Economic Management and Strategy*; *Journal of Behavioral and Experimental Finance*; *Journal of Economic Behavior and Organization*; *Journal of Public Economic Theory*; *Industrial Marketing Management*.

Option 1

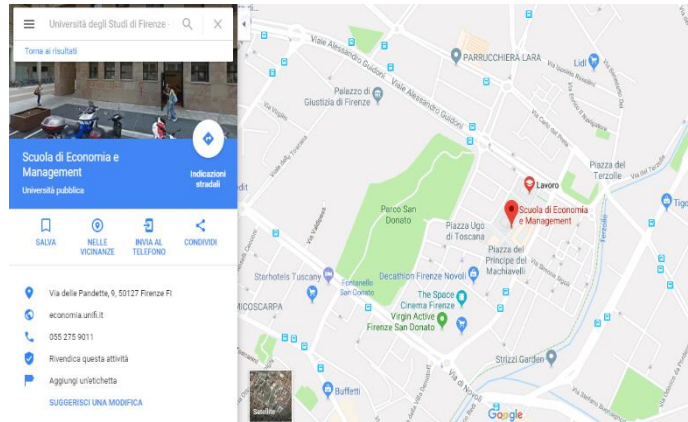
- Take **Tram T2** from Firenze Santa Maria Novella central train station (both tram stops “Unità” and “Alemanni-Stazione” are fine)
